## **CUNNINGHAM LAUNCHES MOBILE CLERK'S OFFICE IN ELGIN AND DUNDEE AS PART OF CLERK'S ACCESSIBILITY PROGRAM**

**Kane County Clerk John A. Cunningham** is proud to announce the launch of the **Mobile Clerk's Office**, an initiative to bring the services of the County Clerk's Office into communities throughout Kane County.

The Clerk's Office has partnered with local governments in Kane County to host the Mobile Clerk's Office so that residents can request copies of birth, death, marriage and civil union certificates, apply for passports, as well as register to vote.

The **Mobile Clerk's Office** will be at the **Elgin Township Supervisor's Office**, 729 S. McLean Blvd., Elgin, on **Thursday, March 8**, and at the **Dundee Township Supervisor's Office**, 611 E. Main St., East Dundee, on **Thursday, March 15**. Hours for the Mobile Clerk's Office will be 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (closed for lunch from Noon to 1:00 p.m.)

Cunningham said, "I am thrilled that we are ready to launch the Mobile Clerk's Office. We have been planning this new addition to the Clerk's Accessibility Program for a while and now we can take our office on the road to provide the Office's services to residents in their own communities. I am grateful for our local government partners, including Elgin Township and Dundee Township, for allowing us to bring our Office to the people."

The Mobile Clerk's Office is part of the **Clerk's Accessibility Program (CAP)**, which has **increased accessibility of resources to Kane County residents**. Through CAP, the Clerk's Office has provided **expanded services** to residents **outside of normal business hours** and **in their communities**.

The Saturday passport events are another initiative of the CAP. On February 3, 2018 the Office served more than 100 residents interested in applying for passports. The next Saturday passport event at the Clerk's Office, 719 S. Batavia Ave., Geneva, will be Saturday, March 10, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Cunningham added, "I understand that people have busy lives and cannot always get to our office in Geneva on weekdays. In addition to expanding services in the main office, Through the Clerk's Accessibility Program, we have been able to expand services and resources to give residents even more for their money. We look forward to expanding this initiative to additional areas across the county."

The Kane County Clerk's Office is responsible for several major functions, including acting as custodian of County records, registrar of vital records, chief election official, as well as extending taxes.
